

## School Uniform at Roe Farm Primary School

### Home School Agreement

You are all aware that as a school we have a set uniform for your child to wear. The school's uniform policy is a crucial part of school life and promotes a positive ethos for learning for children in school. It is important that your children are smart and take pride in their appearance ready for learning each and every day. When moving to secondary school there will be the same expectation so we believe it is important to support and work together with them as we do with you.

#### The school uniform consists of:

- ◆ Black/Grey trousers or skirt
- ◆ White polo shirt
- ◆ Long or short sleeved shirt with a collar
- ◆ White socks
- ◆ Black shoes
- ◆ Red or blue jumper/cardigan



#### During the Summer months when the weather begins to get warmer the school uniform consists of:

- ◆ Red or Blue check dress
- ◆ White polo shirt
- ◆ Smart black/grey shorts
- ◆ White socks
- ◆ Black shoes
- ◆ Sandals (No bright colours): Should your child wish to wear sandals please make sure they wear socks



**PLEASE NOTE: Black shoes DOES NOT INCLUDE PUMPS OR TRAINERS!**

#### School jumpers and cardigans are available to buy in school with our school logo at a cost of:

£6.75 for jumpers  
£7.95 for cardigans

#### For PE children are expected to wear:

Black shorts  
White t - shirt  
Black pumps

## Homework and Reading at Farm Primary School

### Home School Agreement

In addition to school uniform it is important your child takes responsibility for their own learning and education.

All children in school will be given homework on a weekly basis. The day of this will vary, depending on the team they are in. When your child begins in their new class his/her class teacher will inform you of the relevant day.

Homework activities and tasks will include Reading, Literacy and Numeracy.

Your child will bring a homework diary home for you to fill in and complete when they have completed homework or read to you at home.

Book bags are available to buy in our school office so your child can keep all of their belongings together at a cost of £2.52.



In school it is our aim, with support from families to promote and develop the love for reading.

Your child will be given two reading books:

- ◆ One will be kept in school
- ◆ One will be for your child to bring home and share with you.

This is a chance for you talk about what has happened, what might happen and what they may or may not have enjoyed.

We understand that there may be occasions where books may become slightly worn.

However, in school there is a charging policy for lost or damaged books :

£5.00 when a book may have been lost

£2.00 for a book when it has been damaged.
