

# Roald Dahl (Year 4)




### AUTHOR BIOGRAPHY

### Who is Roald Dahl?

- · He was born in Cardiff, Wales in 1916.
- He attended Repton school in Derbyshire.
- His early years were blighted by the death of his older sister and father.
- Dahl served as a fighter pilot during World War 2.

What inspired Roald to write?
Roald Dahl was inspired by his own children, and he routinely made up stories for them at bedtime. These stories often turned into his published books. For instance, his first book, James and the Giant Peach, began as a bedtime story. Family has always had a big effect on Dahl's writing.


#### VOCABULARY
